

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Candidates may check their allotted dates and time for appearing in skill test of welding and carpentry on the website **www.utcsdm.org**
- 2) The candidate for skill test in carpentry and welding must report at **CHANDIGARH COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY (DIPLOMA WING), SECTOR 26, CHANDIGARH** on allotted date and time as displayed on the website **www.utcsdm.org**.
- 3) The candidates must carry a copy of passport size photograph for identity card.
- 4) The candidates can go through the sample test project format available on website **www.utcsdm.org** under the link resources.
- 5) The task for skill test will be on the guidelines given in the sample test project **BUT WILL NOT BE THE SAME**.
- 6) Candidates before coming for skill test will check their eligibility as displayed on the website www.utcsdm.org under link skill competition. The eligibility for appearing in the skill test is as follows
 - a) **Residents of Chandigarh or students who have completed/pursuing education from the institutes located in Chandigarh.**
 - b) **Should be born on or after 01/01/1997 for all skill competition except Mechatronics, Aircraft and Manufacturing Team Challenge for which should be born on or after 01/01/1994**

Instructions for candidates

- 1) The candidates will carry the **ADMIT CARD** (Sent to them on their registered e-mail), date of birth certificate (for age proof), College **I-CARD**, **AADHAR CARD** or any other certificate for residence proof of U.T Chandigarh to checking their eligibility.
- 2) Candidature of the candidates who are not found eligible as per the norms of the competition rules on the date of skill competition will not be allowed to appear in the skill test.
- 3) Mobile phones are not allowed in the Exam during skill test.
- 4) Candidates can keep clear water bottles with them.
- 5) During the skill test the candidates will have in reach nothing but essentials should be on the desk. Non-essential materials must be kept out of reach.
- 6) No outside help is to be taken, if the candidate is found to be using any unfair means then he/she will be debarred from the skill test and will be awarded zero marks.
- 7) The candidates should reach the test centre as mentioned/conveyed/informed to them by the respective test centres preferably 15 minutes prior to the start of test. The candidates will be seated in the test centre after the test is over till asked to leave.
- 8) No student will be allowed to appear in the skill test after 15 minutes of the start of the test.
- 9) **No candidates are allowed to re-enter the exam/ test centre if he/she leaves/QUITS the exam/ test centre during the conduct of exam**
- 10) All candidates will abide by rules and regulations with regards to health, safety, and environment displayed at the competition venue.
- 10) All candidates will wear the required protective clothing.
- 11) All candidates will assume liability for all risks of injury and damage to property, loss of property, which might be associated with or without results, from participation in the event. The Organizers will not be liable for any damage. However in case of injury, the candidate will immediately inform the organizers for medical attention.
