Below is the information for the Mobile Robotic Competition being organised at Indo-Swiss Training Centre on 12th and 13th of April 2018.

Please Note that individual candidate has to appear with his own robot according to Test Project in the sample test project, there is no team formation. We will only provide the infrastructure for the competition i.e. the court.

Candidates are advised to bring the necessary tools they need to use for dismantling and assembly, programming etc., please go through the Sample test Project for details.

You must go through the Sample Test Project in Mobile Robotics to familiarize yourselves with the question and marking pattern. The problem defined can vary 10 to 20% on competition day.

Eligibility:

- Residents of Chandigarh or students who have completed/pursuing education from the institutes located in Chandigarh.
- Should be born on or after 01/01/1997 for all skill competition except Mechatronics , Aircraft and Manufacturing Team Challenge for which should be born on or after 01/01/1994

Important Instructions

1. Please check the website <http://www.utcsdm.org/> for eligibility and schedule or information.
2. The candidate must report at Indo-Swiss Training Centre-CSIR-CSIO, Sector 30, Chandigarh on allotted date at sharp 9:00a.m.
3. Competitors are advised to use above mentioned Roll Nos. during examination.
4. Please bring your passport size photo Original and Self attested copy of Date of Birth certificate, Aadhar Card, Chandigarh Residence Proof OR Institute ID/Certificate for eligibility purpose and Submission
5. Please check date sheet for venue and timings schedule on portal.
6. The task will be on the guidelines in the test project BUT NOT THE SAME , the change can be 10 to 20% and duration can be different.

Uniform Standard

1. The candidate must wear a clean clothing covering full body.
2. Safety shoes covering full feet.
3. Use PPE during Dismantling and assembly

Standard toolkit: candidates are required to bring their own toolkit.

General Rules

1. The candidates are required to adhere to all safety standards during competition at allotted area of work.
2. Candidates are required to work on the allotted station/table only.
3. No technical help will be provided by experts.

Health, Safety and Environment
